

Rules

The Killington Photo Scavenger Hunt is a fun way to explore Killington!

How it works:

- Sign up your team on <u>www.KillingtonRec.com</u>. There is no limit on team size, so you can be a team of one or recruit all of your family and friends.
- All teams need to be registered by midnight on Sunday, September 21th to qualify for scavenger hunt prizes.
- The scavenger hunt list will be e-mailed to all registered participants on Monday, September 22th.
- Teams that find at least 30 items on the hunt list will be eligible to pick up a prize.

How to hunt for items:

- Take a picture of an item on the hunt list and upload it to http://www.flickr.com (you'll need a Flickr account to do this and Flickr accounts are free).
- Join the group "2014 Killington Scavenger Hunt". Create a set, to which you'll add all of your photo submissions. Each photo must include 3 tags (Note: tags must be separated by double quotation marks):

YOUR TEAM NAME 2014 KILLINGTON SCAVENGER HUNT NUMBER OF THE ITEM FROM THE HUNT LIST (i.e. KSH 1)

Please add a short description to any photos where the hunt items is difficult to see or identify.

• Add the set to the group "2014 Killington Scavenger Hunt."

FAQ

- Teams must provide their own cameras.
- Each hunt item must have its own photo You can't submit the same picture for multiple hunt items.
- All photos must be taken between Monday, September 22th through Sunday, September 28th and taken in the Town of Killington.
- All photos must be uploaded by 11:59 pm on Sunday, September 28th. Late submission will not be accepted.
- Winners will be announced on Monday, September 29th.
- Digitally altered photos (i.e. Photoshopped) are not allowed and will be disqualified.
- All submitted photos may be used for future Town of Killington marketing. By participating in the hunt and uploading photos, you acknowledge that you understand that this is done for fun and for the purposes of participating in the scavenger hunt and does not imply any commercial or monetary relationship or obligation on the Town of Killington.
- All decision by the judges are final. No exceptions.
- Obey all traffic laws, federal laws and all other laws!
